Updated January 2024

The National Law Center on Homelessness & Poverty (dba National Homelessness Law Center) places a high priority on protecting the privacy of our donors. This policy explains what types of personal information is collected by the Law Center and how this information is used.

What Personal Information We Collect

The Law Center collects information from donors that may include name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, amount donated, comments, and any other personal information provided to us.

How We May Use Your Personal Information

Donor personal information may be used for the following:

- Acknowledging contributions and thanking donors. We occasionally recognize donors for their participation in fundraising and other events in annual reports and promotional materials. Please let us know if you would prefer to remain anonymous.
- Communicating about upcoming fundraising and other activities.
- Responding to donor inquiries.
- Internal research to improve communications.
- Record keeping as required by law and best nonprofit practices.
- Reporting to applicable agencies as required as terms of our nonprofit status.
